

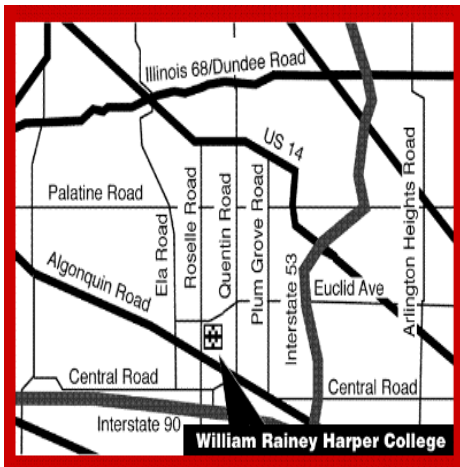
## How to get to the Harper College Wojcik Conference Center

From the North: Take Highway 53 south to Algonquin Road exit. Go west on Algonquin Road to Harper College. Turn north on Roselle Road for the main entrance to the Wojcik Conference Center.

From the South: Take Highway 53 north to Algonquin Road exit. Go west on Algonquin Road to Harper College. Turn north on Roselle Road for the main entrance to the Wojcik Conference Center.

From the East: Go west on the Northwest Tollway (I-90) to the Roselle Road exit. Go north on Roselle Road to Harper College Wojcik Conference Center entrance.

From the West: Go east on the Northwest Tollway (I-90) to Highway 53. Go north on Highway 53 to the Algonquin Road exit. Go west on Algonquin Road to Harper College. Turn north on Roselle Road for the main entrance to the Wojcik Conference Center.
