Improve your understanding of these important materials.

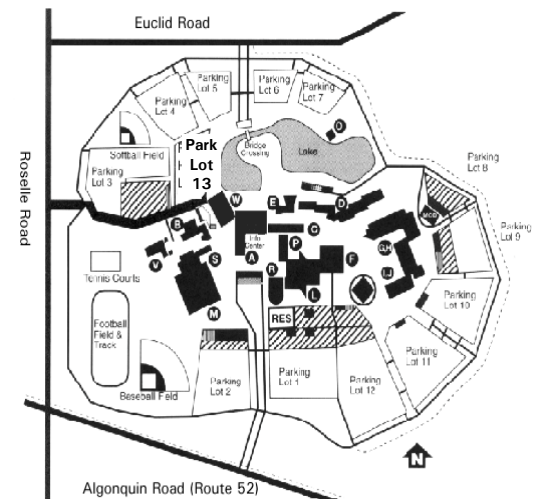

How to Get to the Harper College Wojcik Conference Center
