Dr. Brandt has over twenty years of professional experience in environmental, safety, and health (ESH). He has held a variety of technical, leadership, and management positions in industry, consulting, government, and academia. He has served clients in various industries including manufacturing, coal gasification, oil shale mining and refining, chemical processing, electronics manufacturing, research and development, commercial services, hazardous waste sites, and in government and academia.

As a leading authority and recognized expert in activity-based cost management (ABCM), Dr. Brandt has extensive experience lecturing and teaching ABCM principles and model building, performing organizational cost analysis, and assisting organizations improve operational performance. He has studied and applied ABCM since 1993. While at the University of Michigan, he researched and wrote his doctoral thesis using ABCM to determine the cost of ESH departments and programs. His extensive experience working in ESH, performing financial analyses, lecturing, presenting seminars, leading organizational change, and publishing in the area of ABCM, cost and financial management, and quality management are summarized below.

Dr. Brandt serves as a Clinical Associate Professor of Public Health at Tulane University of Public Health and Tropical Medicine; Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, College of Public Health; as a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of New Mexico, School of Medicine, Master of Public Health Program; and as Affiliate faculty at Colorado State University, Department of Environmental Health.
