Presenter

Dr. Daniel Hryhorczuk, M.D., MPH, UIC

Dr. Hryhorczuk is a tenured Professor in the Departments of Environmental and Occupational Health Sciences and Epidemiology, and is the Director of the Great Lakes Center of Chicago's Toxikon consortium. He is a physician who is board-certified in occupational and environmental medicine and in medical toxicology. He founded the Occupational Health Service Institute and established the centers in Children's Environmental Health and in Global Environmental and Occupational Health.

Dr. Hryhorczuk is also a member of the National Advisory Committee for Occupational Health. He has led UIC SPH team that prepared the report for IDPH on "Occupational Disease in Illinois," which led to establishing the state's first occupational disease registry. He is the lead UIC SPH investigator in the collaborative City Of Chicago, USEPA, and UIC SPH study of GIS mapping of lead poisoning in Chicago.

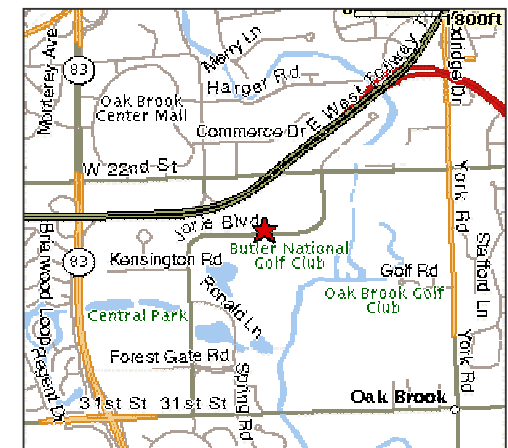
Registration Deadline

Directions

From the North: Take Tri-State Tollway (I-294) south to Cermak Road (22nd Street) exit. Turn west (left) onto Cermak Road. Proceed west to third stoplight. Turn south (left) onto Jorie Boulevard. 1010 Jorie is the third building on the right.
Or

Take North-South Tollway (I-355) south to East-West Tollway (I-88) east onto South Tri-State Tollway (I-294) exit. Then take the York Road exit. Turn south (left) onto York Road to stoplight. Turn west (right) onto Cermak Road (22nd Street). Turn south (left) at first stoplight onto Jorie Boulevard. 1010 Jorie is the third building on the right.

From the South: Take Tri-State Tollway (I-294) north onto the East-West Tollway (I-88) exit immediately after the toll plaza, exit onto Cermak Road (22nd Street) exit. Turn east (right) onto Cermak Road. Proceed east to second stoplight. Turn south (right) onto Jorie Boulevard. 1010 Jorie is the third building on the right.

OR

Take North-South Tollway (I-355) north East-West Tollway (I-88) east onto South Tri-State Tollway (I-294) exit. Then take the York Road exit. Turn south (left) onto York Road to first stoplight. Turn west (right) onto Cermak Road (22nd Street). Turn south (left) at first stoplight onto Jorie. 1010 Jorie Boulevard is the third building.

From the West: Take East-West Tollway (I-88) east onto South Tri-State Tollway (I-294) exit. Then take the York Road exit. Turn south (left) onto York Road to first stoplight. Turn west (right) onto Cermak Road (22nd street). Turn south (left) at first stoplight onto Jorie Boulevard. 1010 Jorie is the third building on the right.

From the East: Take the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) west onto East-West Tollway (I-88) exit. Immediately after the toll plaza exit onto Cermak Road (22nd Street) exit. Turn east to second stoplight. Turn south (right) onto Jorie Boulevard. 1010 Jorie is the third building on the right.

OR

Take the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) to Roosevelt Road west. Follow Roosevelt Road west to York Road south. Go south on York to 22nd Street west. Take 22nd Street west to Jorie Boulevard (1st stoplight). Turn left from 22nd to 1010 Jorie.
