Argonne National Laboratory is located **between Interstates I-355 and I-294, just south of I-55**. It is between major streets, Lemont Road and Cass Avenue, immediately south of I-55.

**Note:**

All visitors must enter from Cass Avenue and pull into the Argonne Information (Visitor Reception) Center, just to the right of the guard gate to get their pass and site map. The Argonne Guest House is on Outer Circle Drive near Meridian, just west of the Mobil Service Station. There are signs indicating the route from the gate to the Argonne Guest House.

**Directions:**

**From O'Hare Airport**, drive east (toward Chicago) on Interstate 190 to the exit for Interstate 294 south (toward Indiana). Go south on Interstate 294 to the exit for Interstate 55 south (toward St. Louis). Take I-55 south to the exit for *South* Cass Avenue. Exit at South Cass Avenue, drive over the overpass, and you will see a black vertical sign for Argonne National Laboratory at the first road (Northgate Road) on your right. Turn onto Northgate Road, and go about a mile and a half. Stop at the Argonne Information Center (Visitor Center) which will be on your right, just before the security gate.

**From Midway Airport**, take Cicero Avenue north to the entrance to Interstate 55 south (toward St. Louis), which will be on your left, then proceed as described above.
