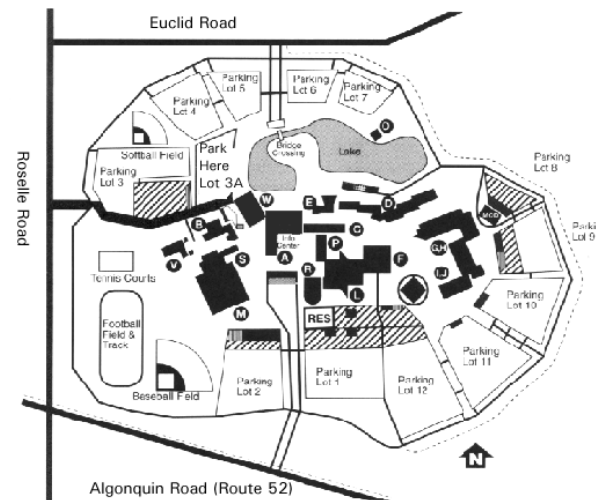

Harper College Wojcik Conference Center



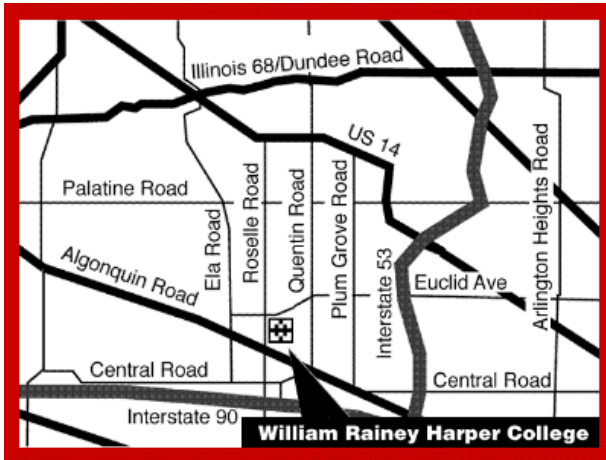
How to get to the Harper College Wojcik Conference Center
